Student Athlete Expectations

Through sports, we can teach self-discipline, time management, leadership, self-worth and personal accountability. Being a member of an DCS athletic team is a privilege, athletes are expected to model the following Trailblazer standards at all times.

Respect for classmates/school

Respect for coaches/officials

Any athlete unable to uphold these standards will result in the following starting **the first day of school:**

- **1st Offense** Suspended for **1 game**
- **2nd Offense** Suspended for **25%** of the remaining games
- **3rd Offense** will result in the student/athlete being **dismissed** from the team
- **4th Offense** student will **no longer** be able to compete for any Blazer Athletic team for the remainder of the school year.

Fighting: Any student athlete engaging in the following scenarios will face the following disciplinary actions:

- Putting hands/equipment on another person in a confrontational manner.
- Verbally communicating with another person in a threatening manner **at school or in a game setting.**
 - **1st Offense** Suspended for **25%** of the remaining games
 - **2nd Offense** will result in the student/athlete being **dismissed** from the team.
 - **3rd Offense** student will **no longer** be able to compete for any Blazer Athletic team the remainder of the school year.

Academics

All student athletes must be in good academic standing, which includes acceptable academic performance, based on the student's ability, individual classroom community expectations, and a strong work ethic demonstrated by participation, effort, and follow through in academic work.

A student will be considered **ELIGIBLE** to participate in athletics at Discovery Charter School, if their most recent Blazers Athletics Progress Report reflects:

- **Passing grade or better in all subjects as well as a satisfactory Blazers Athletics Progress Report**

A student will be considered **SUSPENDED** should his/her most recent Blazers Academic/Athletics Progress Report reflect any one or a combination starting **the first day of school**:

- One grade lower than a C or one incomplete in any subject.
- Removal from a classroom for disruptive behavior or being actively disengaged
- Skipping class
- **1st offense** will eliminate a student from competition for a **one-week period**. At the end of the **one-week period**, all grades/behaviors will be checked, and if all grades/behaviors are passing/trending up, then the student-athlete will regain eligibility. During the period in which the student-athlete is ineligible, he/she will be required to practice with the team.
 - Complete the Blazers Academic Accountability Think Sheet
- **2nd offense** will result in the student/athlete being **dismissed** from the team.
- **3rd Offense** student will **no longer** be able to compete for any Blazer Athletic team the remainder of the school year. **Out-of-school suspension will result in automatic dismissal from the team.**

Sportsmanship

Transportation for Athletic Events

Student transportation will be provided when available to and from all Blazer Athletic events. If student transportation is by private vehicle, the vehicles owner's liability coverage is applicable to any vehicular accident. Parent or adult drivers should be aware that they may be held responsible for injuries to any individuals they are transporting and must certify that any private vehicle used is covered by at least the North Carolina state required insurance coverage. All student athletes' who travel with the team to an away event must return with the team. Exceptions are made if parents or guardians are present to accept responsibility for transportation after an athletic event. Student athletes are not to ride home with any other person other than family or guardians unless an assumption of risk and responsibility has been declared.

By signing below, you are assuming the risk of transporting your child as well as the agreed player you may transport from any Blazers Athletic Event. In the event you give permission for a different person other than the signee of this form to transport your child home from a Blazers Athletic event you are waiving Discovery Charter School of any potential risks or injury caused by an accident, or any other form of damages caused in the transportation of your child.
